

NEWFOUNDLAND PUPPY DEPOSIT INFORMATION

In receipt of \$500 for the purchase of a Newfoundland puppy. Total purchase price is \$2500.

1. This deposit is not refundable after the puppy is 7 weeks old. If the puppy does not pass health clearances the purchaser will either be placed on the list for the next litter or the deposit will be refunded. Purchasers choice.
2. Deposits may be made via paypal or zelle. Send deposits to paypal@bhnews.com. Deposits may also be sent via personal check, however, if your check is returned we will seek legal remedies and your reservation of a puppy will be canceled. Receipt of deposit would be the date your check clears the bank in the case of a personal check.
3. **Cash is the ONLY acceptable form of payment on day of pick up.**
When the puppy is ready to go to its new home, the buyer agrees to take delivery of the puppy. This normally occurs between 9 and 10 weeks from birth. If we "hold" your puppy for you, there is a \$12.00 per day boarding fee.
4. The breeder's decision is final as to the puppy you receive, but we will make very effort to provide you with the puppy you want. It isn't practical to pick your puppy before the vet visit because arranging visits in priority order based on when deposits are received never works. Everyone has a different schedule.
5. All puppies are purchased with the understanding that they will not be spayed before 24 months of age. The only exception will be if there is an understanding with the breeder prior to deposit.
6. All puppies received their vaccines between 7-8 weeks of age. You should get a booster when they see your vet the first time and rabies shots are typically given between 12 – 16 weeks. Any other vaccines are your choice. We do not vaccinate for lymes or lepto here. **CAUTION! We had a 10 week old puppy die after being given a lymes vaccine. A necropsy was done and the cardiologist determined that the vaccine killed the puppy.**
7. All puppies are registered under a limited AKC registration. This allows all event activities except conformation and does not allow breeding or registration of any offspring.
8. The buyer must provide a fenced secure area for the puppy to exercise before taking possession of the puppy unless prior understanding exists between buyer and seller. Since puppies are not altered before 2 yrs of age so invisible fences do not work. If you do not have a fenced yard or a secure enclosure you will have to be outside with the dog at all times. You won't be able to stop a motivated newfoundland intent on breeding if something happens while a bitch is in season.
9. Any refunds are issued when the puppies go home. i.e. if you cancel your reservation on week 2, the refund will be sent week 9-10 when puppies go home.
